
Goal Levels



Symptom Reduction or Management Goals address cognitions, emotions, behaviors or physiological responses that have emerged or have been exacerbated by a work-related incident/exposure. These goals are aimed at reducing symptoms or self-managing ongoing symptoms.

Functional Restoration Goals address impairments in the injured person's ability to engage in their personal, social and/or occupational environments. These goals involve skill development, adaptation, or accommodation.
